QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. Within Exhibit C Agreement for Rental of Equipment, there exists a rate sheet with the hourly, daily and weekly rates to utilize different types of equipment. We will make a note of this at this time but not knowing the site conditions/restrictions, and/or placement of furniture, we do not know when or if, this will be required. Can you clarify if my local installation company needs to be prepared to utilize this equipment?

Contractor is responsible for delivery, offloading, uncrating, assembling in an area adjacent to the loading dock and removal of dunnage. HCC rental of equipment at listed prices is available without an operator. HCC requires the operator of equipment to be certified whether using HCC or third party equipment.

2. For the (10) round table carts called out for you in your equipment specifications list, can you provide the model number for the round table cart that you need quoted? We have taken a look at the different carts provided by PS Furniture, and could not link it to a model number offered by this manufacturer

Model Number: CRTXPTR3810L

3. For the Cocktail tables, which we have gathered are from PS Furniture, the equipment specification sheet calls out for (100) each 36" Hexagon table tops, (100) each X-bases, (100) each column at 30" high and (100) each column at 42" high. Your rate card asks for pricing for a qty. of (100) cocktail tables, how do we present pricing for each base option?

4. Your rate card does not include an installation cost field, only a shipping field will be shipping FOB Hawai'i Convention Center. Should we be including a cost for our installers to deliver and stage the furniture throughout the convention center?

If it is, we could not find the called out upholstery to be used. The Fabric: ML-7-220 Textured Weave-River is not a fabric provided by MityLite. Is this to be treated as a COM? Has MityLite approved of its use on the Encore Series CX chair? Can you provide us with the manufacturer of this fabric?

No, this is not to be treated as Customer Owned Material (COM).

Yes, MityList has approved the use of specified fabric on the Encore Series CX chair.

Fabric manufacturer: Ennis Fabrics

Fabric identification: ML-7-220, Texture Weave, River, with crypton barrier (custom made)

7. Is the pricing expected to be all inclusive with offloading or dock to dock? Please explain in detail what is required in terms of the delivery. Clients typically offload their own product to save overall cost.

Contractor is responsible for delivery, offloading, uncrating, assembling in an area adjacent to the loading dock and removal of dunnage.

8. Please clarify what is required for shipping and delivery of the products. Our standard freight is to drop ship as our products do not require assembly. Please advise if further service is required such as inside delivery, removal of dunnage, or offloading, etc.

Contractor is responsible for delivery, offloading, uncrating, assembling in an area adjacent to the loading dock and removal of dunnage
