QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

1. The rigging equipment list on the RFP has regular spanset's on it in large quantities along with 5' steel cables. I believe that this is based on past inventory requirements. Most rigging companies now use GAC Flex spansets. These "GAC Flex" spansets are made in the USA and are black with a green identification tag stating their rated load limits. GAC is short for Galvanized Aircraft Cable, which makes up the steel core of this spanset. Unlike traditional spansets with a polyester yarn core, these spansets withstand higher temperatures. In the past you would use a polyester spanset and back it with the 5' steel cable for fire / heat resistance. If you use a GAC Flex spanset, with it's steel core, the 5' steel cable is not necessary. Please let us know if this is acceptable to you.
